



Arrest Made in Sunnyvale Armed Robberies

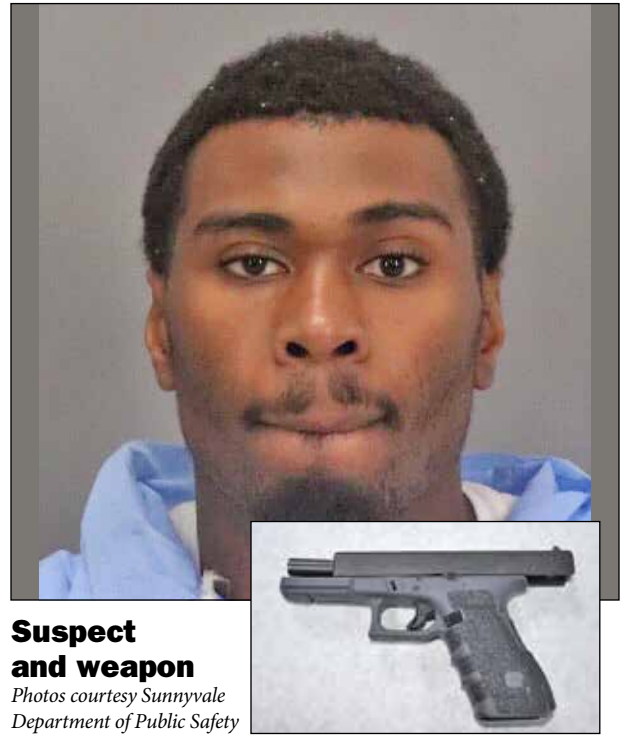
AN ARREST WAS MADE on November 1 in connection with two armed robberies that occurred on October 28 on Iris Ave. near Fair Oaks Ave.

At approximately 6:40 a.m. that morning, a resident was walking to his vehicle when he was approached by a subject armed with a handgun. The subject demanded his personal belongings and then fled on foot.

That evening, at approximately 10:25 p.m., a group of three individuals were robbed at gunpoint in the same manner.

Sunnyvale Public Safety Officers investigated the two incidents and on November 1, contacted Daniel Williams in the area of Fair Oaks Ave. and McKinley Ave. and found him to be in possession of stolen property belonging to one of the victims.

A search warrant was obtained and investigators located a handgun and additional stolen property. Williams was arrested for the armed robberies and transported to Santa Clara County Jail.

ECR/Poplar Leading Pedestrian Interval Installed by CalTrans

GREAT NEWS that has already been noticed by many is that CalTrans has implemented Leading Pedestrian Interval (LPI) at both the ECR/Poplar and ECR/Henderson intersections.

What is LPI? Check out the photo I took the morning of November 8 from the Starbucks at El Camino and Poplar. This pedestrian is crossing from the northeast corner to the southeast corner and notice that the pedestrian cross signal has come on before the traffic signal turns green (about six seconds before). Previously, the pedestrian signal and the traffic green light would change simultaneously.

With Leading Pedestrian Interval,



crosswalk users get exclusive crossing time, increasing their visibility, decreasing potential conflicts and increasing safety.

Advocacy works! Thank you to all who contacted CalTrans and the offices of Sen. Hill and Asm. Berman. There is more to be done here but LPI is a definite step in the right direction.
